



2022 Child Safety Week

Competition Entry Guidelines

1. The Competition is open to all students in Catholic primary schools and secondary colleges and all school-aged children in parishes in the Diocese of Sale.
2. Entries must relate to the 2022 theme: *Every child, in every community, needs a fair go and a chance to grow up safe and supported. What makes you feel safe and supported in your community, school or at home?*
3. All work submitted must be the original work of the student/s.
4. Entries can be completed by individual students or groups of students.
5. Entries can be either a poster (hand created or digital) or a video (videography or animation).
6. Entries must only be submitted in electronic form via email:
 - a. Digital or scanned posters in high quality PDF or
 - b. Videos in MP4, **no longer than 1 minute**
7. Each school/parish can **submit no more than five** entries. Remaining works can be displayed within the school or church.
8. In the submission email, you must include the description of the entry, the student's name/s, school or parish, and year level.
9. You must also confirm that all students and staff who appear in photographs or video entries have signed consent for use of images as entries may be shared via digital and social media.
10. The judging categories are:
 - a. Best of primary school age entries
 - b. Best of secondary college age entries.
11. Submissions will be judged according to:
 - a. Originality
 - b. Relevance to the theme
 - c. Impact
 - d. Video (MP4 format only) entries being 1 minute or less.
12. **Winning entries from each category will be selected for distribution to schools and parishes for the promotion of Child Safety Week in September.**
13. Judging will be conducted by the Diocese of Sale Child Safety Week Committee.
14. The judges' decision is final.
15. Entries become the property of the Diocese of Sale and may be used for publicity purposes. The creator/s will be acknowledged at all times.
16. Entries must be received **by 4.30 pm Friday 22 July 2022**. No late entries accepted.
17. For large files, especially videos, please store in Google Drive and provide a link for download in the email submission.
