First Reading Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

They were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak different languages.

When Pentecost day came round, the apostles had all met in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise of which filled the entire house in which they were sitting; and something appeared to them that seemed like tongues of fire; these separated and came to rest on the head of each of them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak foreign languages as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech.

Now there were devout men living in Jerusalem from every nation under heaven, and at this sound they all assembled, each one bewildered to hear these men speaking his own language. They were amazed and astonished. 'Surely' they said 'all these men speaking are Galileans? How does it happen that each of us hears them in his own native language? Parthians, Medes and Elamites; people from Mesopotamia, Judaea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya round Cyrene; as well as visitors from Rome – Jews and proselytes alike – Cretans and Arabs; we hear them preaching in our own language about the marvels of God.'

There is a variety of gifts but always the same Spirit; there are all sorts of service to be done, but always to the same Lord; working in all sorts of different ways in different people, it is the same God who is working in all of them. The particular way in which the Spirit is given to each person is for a good purpose.

Just as a human body, though it is made up of many parts, is a single unit because all these parts, though many, make one body, so it is with Christ. In the one Spirit we were all baptised, Jews as well as Greeks, slaves as well as citizens, and one Spirit was given to us all to drink.

As the Father sent me, so I send you: Receive the Holy Spirit.



Jubilee Year Celebrations: Jubilee of Clergy and Religious

As part of the ongoing Jubilee Year of Hope, Leongatha and Korumburra Parishes have been invited to serve as a *pilgrim centre* for the month of June, in honour of the Jubilee of the Clergy and Religious within our diocese.

This celebration will include two key events:

On the weekend of 21st/22nd June, all Sale diocesan clergy will participate in a “*pulpit swap*,” visiting neighbouring parishes to celebrate Masses and Sacraments. This initiative aims to promote prayer and awareness for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. (Leongatha will swap with Warragul on 28/29 June)

On Friday, 27th June at 4:00 PM, Bishop Greg will celebrate a special Jubilee Mass in Leongatha, joined by clergy, religious, and pilgrims from across the diocese. This will be followed by a light dinner and refreshments.

Korumburra Parish will also participate in this Jubilee celebration in a unique and prayerful way. On **Friday, 27th June**, the **Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in Korumburra Church from 12:00 PM onwards**, offering a special time of Adoration focused on *praying for vocations*. Parishioners are warmly invited to come and pray before the Blessed Sacrament, asking that more young people may hear and respond to God’s call in their lives—especially to the priesthood within our diocese.

From **12:00 PM to 3:30 PM**, pilgrims travelling through Korumburra will also be welcomed to stop at our church to join in silent prayer for this important intention. At **3:30 PM**, we will conclude Adoration and travel to Leongatha for the Jubilee Mass at 4:00 PM.

The Choir will be singing at the Jubilee of Clergy and Religious Mass on Friday 27th June at 4pm. Choir Practice will be held on Tuesday 10 & 17 June 7.30pm in the Parish Centre. New members from both Leongatha and Korumburra Parishes are invited to attend.
