First Reading Acts of the Apostles 14:21-27

A reading from the Acts of the Apostles

They assembled the church and gave an account of all that God had done with them.

Paul and Barnabas went back through Lystra and Iconium to Antioch. They put fresh heart into the disciples, encouraging them to persevere in the faith. 'We all have to experience many hardships' they said 'before we enter the kingdom of God.' In each of these churches they appointed elders, and with prayer and fasting they commended them to the Lord in whom they had come to believe.

They passed through Pisidia and reached Pamphylia. Then after proclaiming the word at Perga they went down to Attalia and from there sailed for Antioch, where they had originally been commended to the grace of God for the work they had now completed.

On their arrival they assembled the church and gave an account of all that God had done with them, and how he had opened the door of faith to the pagans.

• On the weekend of 21st/22nd June, all Sale diocesan clergy will participate in a "pulpit swap," visiting neighbouring parishes to celebrate Masses and Sacraments. This initiative aims to promote prayer and awareness for vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

On Friday, 27th June at 4:00 PM, Bishop Greg will celebrate a special Jubilee Mass in Leongatha, joined by clergy, religious, and pilgrims from across the diocese. This will be followed by a light dinner and refreshments. Korumburra Parish will also participate in this Jubilee celebration in a unique and prayerful way. On Friday, 27th June, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed in Korumburra Church from 12:00 PM onwards, offering a special time of Adoration focused on praying for vocations.
