"Let's sing with the Pope"

A new initiative from the Pontifical Institute of Sacred Music in Rome uses social media to help people learn the basics of Gregorian chant.

The Pontifical Institute of Sacred Music announced a new series of videos for social media aimed at teaching Gregorian chant to all who want to learn it.

"Let's sing with the Pope," the name of the initiative, is hosted by Fr. Robert Mehlhart, O.P., rector of the Institute. The videos will "help the People of God sing along with the Holy Father during the upcoming major liturgical celebrations," said the description of the first video in the series.

"It aims to make the rich heritage of Gregorian chant accessible to all — a universal musical and spiritual language for celebrations such as papal Masses and to promote active and conscious participation in the liturgy."

The first chant taught is the first one a person will hear at Mass: the Sign of the Cross, said Melhart. "Let's note that in the beginning, only the Holy Father sings, but we all make the Sign of the Cross," he added. And in the response "Amen," the second syllable of the word is actually two notes, explained Melhart. Melhart then teaches the response of "Et cum spiritu tuo," which translates to "and with your spirit."

At the conclusion of the video, a person can follow along with actual footage of Pope Leo XIV chanting the Sign of the Cross and greeting the crowd at Mass using the responses they just learned.

Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2025



The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is celebrated in the Southern Hemisphere between Ascension Sunday (1 June 2025) and Pentecost Sunday (8 June 2025), a symbolic date for the unity of the Church. This year we also remember the 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea

We pray during this week and throughout the year that the Spirit will bring Christians closer together.

Pope John Paul II in his encyclical "Ut unum Sint" ("That They May be One") quotes the Second Vatican Council: "This change of heart and holiness of life, along with public and private prayer for the unity of Christians, should be regarded as the soul of the whole ecumenical movement, and can rightly be called 'spiritual ecumenism.'"

Despite the many differences between Christian denominations, the church is united in Christ, and in its constant need for God, and thus its need for prayer. The language of prayer unites Catholic, Orthodox and Protestant believers without letting our differences discourage us or allowing obstacles to get in the way. Prayer also unites us across denominational, national and cultural lines. As Paul says, "...there is neither Jew nor Gentile in Christ, for all are one."

The theme for 2025 is 'Do you believe this?' (John 11:26)

For this year, 2025, the prayers and reflections for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity were prepared by the brothers and sisters of the monastic community of Bose in northern Italy.

This year marks the 1,700th anniversary of the first Christian Ecumenical Council, held in Nicaea, near Constantinople in 325 AD. This commemoration provides a unique opportunity to reflect on and celebrate the common faith of Christians, as expressed in the Creed formulated during this Council; a faith that remains alive and fruitful in our days. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2025 offers an invitation to draw on this shared heritage and to enter more deeply into the faith that unites all Christians.

The Council of Nicaea convoked by the Emperor Constantine, the Council of Nicaea was attended, according to tradition, by 318 Fathers, mostly from the East. The Church, having just emerged from hiding and persecution, was beginning to experience how difficult it was to share the same faith in the different cultural and political contexts of the time. Agreement on the text of the Creed was a matter of defining the essential common foundations on which to build local communities that recognised each other as sister churches, each respecting the diversity of the other. Disagreements had arisen among Christians in the previous decades, which sometimes degenerated into serious conflicts. These disputes were on matters as diverse as: the nature of Christ in relation to the Father; the question of a single date to celebrate Easter and its relationship with the Jewish Passover; opposition to theological opinions considered heretical; and how to reintegrate believers who had abandoned the faith during the persecutions in earlier years.

The approved text of the Creed used the first-person plural, "We believe...". This form emphasised the expression of a common belonging. The Creed was divided into three parts dedicated to the three persons of the Trinity, followed by a conclusion condemning affirmations that were considered heretical. The text of this Creed was revised and expanded at the Council of Constantinople in 381 AD, where the condemnations were removed. This is the form of the profession of faith that Christian churches today recognise as the Nicene-Constantinopolitan Creed, often referred to simply as the Nicene Creed.

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is an opportunity for Christians to explore afresh this living heritage and reappropriate it in ways that are in keeping with contemporary cultures, which are even more diverse today than those of the Christian world at the time of the Council of Nicaea. Living the apostolic faith together today does not imply re-opening the theological controversies of that time, which have continued down the centuries, but rather a prayerful re-reading of the scriptural foundations and ecclesial experiences that led to that Council and its decisions.

The <u>formation.orq.au</u> network emerged following the Plenary Council and Synod on Synodality processes

A bold new initiative has emerged from within the Australian Church. <u>formation.org.au</u>, a professional membership network for people shaping and leading formation for Mission, has officially launched—creating time and space for connection, collaboration, and renewal. Formation is central to the Church's life, and this network aims to support those who are providing formation for Mission working in boardrooms, staff rooms, parish communities, and across all of Church.

Catholic Mission as <u>formation.org.au</u> Company Member, is proud to have been a part of bringing this concept to life. "Inspired by the Gospel and the needs of our time, the vision for formation.org.au is to be a permanent platform for dialogue and connection for all people who are engaged in formation for Mission," says Lana Turvey-Collins, the Lead Facilitator of formation.org.au. "Across the many and varied parts of the Church, deep thinking is taking place around the future of formation for Mission. Important questions are being asked, not only operational as who and how, the questions go deeper to the heart of what it means to be a missionary Church."

As Archbishop Mark Coleridge explains, "Formation in the Christian life is something that God does. It's God doing the work and we cooperating with God in all our programs and all our networks." He reminds us that "we speak about lifelong formation. I can never say that my formation is complete because God has never finished with me. I remain a work in progress." formation.org.au has emerged in response to this Spirit-led momentum, particularly following the Plenary Council and Synod processes, both of which emphasised the need for renewed and integrated approaches to formation for Mission.

According to Sr Monica Cavanagh, Congregational Leader of the Sisters of Saint Joseph, "We know there's a lot of good formation that happens, but it's not integrated or held in a common place. This is a response to that call that came through the Plenary Council and also the work of the Synod on Synodality." formation.org.au seeks to create that common place—a national network that supports and connects formators across ministries and sectors.

Through community-building, mentoring, roundtable dialogue, case studies, shared wisdom, and learning opportunities, the platform offers a range of resources and forums for growth. The founding partners of formation.org.au include dioceses, religious congregations, educators, and facilitators who bring decades of experience in spiritual formation, leadership, and accompaniment.

Rooted in that same spirit of accompaniment and practical mission, the network recognises that today's formators work across a wide range of contexts, including Catholic education and diocesan offices, interfaith programs, lay leadership and ministerial governance bodies, novitiates and seminaries, social services and chaplaincies.

"If you are thinking of joining this network," Archbishop Coleridge says, "what I would say to you is: you've got nothing to lose and potentially a great deal to gain. You will lose nothing, and you will gain a great deal—and that will be good for the whole Church." In this Jubilee Year of Hope, <u>formation.org.au</u> is an invitation to listen, learn, lead, and walk

IF SO, YOU NEED A SPECIAL LICENCE!

It has become common practice in churches to assist congressional singing. This is a helpful way to encourage full participation in the liturgy, especially in the absence of musicians however, up until now it has been illegal without a *'Synchronisation License*.

ONE LICENSE has responded to this copyright requirement and recently launched the Recorded Audio License.

The Recorded Audio License enables License Holders to:

- Use master recordings from Member Publishers in worship services*.
- Use self-made recordings of Member Publisher songs (even MIDI) in worship services.
- Embed master or self-produced recordings into your projections and store them on your website or server.

Paired with a ONE LICENSE Podcast / Streaming License, services containing these master recordings may be streamed or podcasted.

This License also includes practice-track permissions, enabling Music Ministers to:

- Copy demonstration recordings provided by a Member Publisher for your ensemble or choir.
- Copy commercial CDs or mp3s purchased from a Member Publisher or member record company.
- Record your own versions of covered songs for your ensemble (e.g. a specific vocal part or an accompaniment track).
- Burn CDs or mp3s.
- Provide a link to a Dropbox or Google Drive file that can only be accessed by the intended musicians.

Note: If you plan to stream these recorded tracks, a Podcast / Streaming License is also required.

But for an artist, in addition to technical knowledge, there has also to be inspiration, which is a positive form of possession. The true artist does not possess an art but rather is possessed by it..... A diligent dedication to the celebration is required, allowing the celebration itself to convey to us its art." (Desiderio Desideravi #50)
