



## 2021 Child Safety Week

## Poster Competition Entry Guidelines

- 1. The Poster Competition is open to all students in Catholic primary schools and secondary colleges in the Diocese of Sale, and all school-aged children in parishes in the Diocese of Sale.
- 2. Posters must relate to the 2021 theme: *Every child, in every community, needs a fair go*. To treat all of Australia's children fairly, we need to make sure every family and community has what kids need to thrive and be healthy.
- 3. All artwork submitted must be the original work of the student/s.
- 4. Posters can be completed by individual students or groups of students.
- 5. The entries can be of any size but ideally A3 in size and submitted on the A3 entry form (or any size, if this is too difficult) (attached). Only entries on the entry form (attached) will be accepted. Do not add another page on top of this form.
- 6. All entry forms must include the student's name/s, school or parish, and year level.
- 7. Students may submit designs using any or all of the following: charcoal, acrylic paints, oil paints, watercolours, oil pastels, chalk, pencils, textas, crayons, pens, stamps, wax, paper, textiles and embellishments (sitting no higher than 2mm off the page). Please note: no glitter.
- 8. The judging categories are:
  - a. Best of primary school entries
  - b. Best of secondary college individual entries
- 9. Four designs from each category will be selected to be produced into posters for distribution to schools and parishes for the promotion of Child Safety Week.
- 10. Schools and parishes are to submit their top five entries. Remaining posters can be displayed within the school or church.
- 11. Judging will be conducted by the Diocese of Sale Child Safety Campaign Team and will be based on aesthetic appeal, creativity and relevance to the theme. The judges' decision is final.
- 12. Entries become the property of this Office and may be used for publicity purposes. The artist/s will be acknowledged at all times.
- 13. Entries will not be returned. If you wish to retain a copy of the work, please photocopy or scan the image before entering it into the competition.
- 14. Entries must be received by 4.30 pm Tue 3 Aug 2021.
